## Lung Cancer 5K Comes To Dockweiler

This year, lung cancer will kill more men and women in California than breast, colon and prostate cancer combined. Despite this fact, funding for lung cancer has not kept pace with other cancers, and the overall survival rate for lung cancer is 15 percent, the same as it was 35 years ago.

To promote awareness and raise funds for lung cancer research, the National Lung Cancer Partnership is sponsoring the second annual Free to Breathe™ Lung Cancer 5K run/walk and 1.5 mile walk Sunday at Dockweiler State Park. All proceeds will help fund the National Lung Cancer Partnership's research, education, and awareness programs.

The run starts on Vista Del Mar, overlooking the Pacific Ocean at Dockweiler State Park in Playa Del Rey. Additional activities include a morning health expo and a community rally that will take place immediately following the race. Prizes will be awarded to all individuals who raise \$1,500 or more.

The pre-registration fee for the walk is \$25 and day-of registration is \$30. Day-of registration begins at 7 a.m. and the race is scheduled to begin at 8:30 a.m.
